<p><i>The Steamers are to be used for sanitizing the bathroom fixtures, tiles, floors (dependent upon the materials), windows, shelving, toys, chairs, tables, etc. Steamers are not to replace cleaning and are to be used after cleaning.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review the Steamer Manual for assembly.</li> <li>2. In accordance with the Steamer Manual, fill with water accordingly</li> <li>3. Plug the steamer in and turn it on for power. Both green and red lights will come on. The red light will go off when its ready for use.</li> <li>4. Activate the trigger to being steaming.</li> </ol> <p><b>**CAUTION</b> the steamer is hot and makes objects moist. <b>DO NOT</b> over steam surfaces. Steaming can make flooring slippery, use caution.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. Shut the steamer off when finished. Activate the trigger to release any pressure. Unplug the steamer and wait atleast 20 minutes for the steamer to cool down.</li> <li>6.
