**Performance Objective:** The program establishes, trains staff on, implements, and enforces a system of health and safety practices that ensure children are kept safe at all times.

### **Safety Practices**

The program consults [Caring for our Children Basics](#) for additional information to develop and implement adequate safety policies and practices meeting the requirements of 1302.47.

### **System of Safety Practices**

The program develops and implements a system of management, including ongoing training, oversight, correction and continuous improvement in accordance with §1302.102, that includes these policies and practices to ensure all facilities, equipment and materials, background checks, safety training, safety and hygiene practices and administrative safety procedures are adequate to ensure child safety (see policies in HPS sections).

The program reports any safety incidents in accordance with §1302.102(d)(1)(ii).

### **Safety Practices and Responsibilities**

All staff and consultants follow appropriate practices to keep children safe during all activities, including, at a minimum:

- Reporting of suspected or known child abuse and neglect, including that staff comply with applicable federal, state, local, and tribal laws;
- Appropriate indoor and outdoor supervision of children at all times;
- Only releasing children to an authorized adult, and;
- All standards of conduct described in §1302.90(c).
